Guest Speakers – Linda Teeter from Allegan County Legal Assistance Center presented information about the center and requested funding for the upcoming budget year. Board informed her that they had been put in the budget for the \$ 2,000.

Public Participation – Wally Sosnowski requested help in repairing 109th Ave on Pike Lake as it is full of potholes and needs to be built up. Supervisor Kaylor to talk to the County about what can be done to help. Board will review budget to see if gravel can be added for 109th.

Commissioners Report – Gale Dugan – Reported on the commissioner’s meetings this past month. Fourth quarter capital project report received and citizen survey has been completed. Annual report by County Clerk was presented. Vacancies are still open on many County boards at this time.

Fire Chief Report – Pat stated that there were 6 calls in February 2020.

Planning Commission – Royal Thompson. Trailer and camper ordinance to be reviewed in upcoming meetings.

Zoning-Nick Loll – No permits issued and very little activity. Several zoning questions answered during the month. Larry Ladenburger will be assuming zoning administrator position in March.

Assessor - Heather Mitchell: Board of Review on March 11th and 12th. Taxable values increased approximately 1.9% with assessed values increasing higher.

Transfer Station – Kath Wellever has taken over position. Supervisor Kaylor has Dana Randall as backup to Kathy when Kathy not available.

OLD BUSINESS

Trustee Emmons discussed the proposed public access currently being investigated by the DNR. DNR has contract with the owners of the property on Minkler Lake. Trustee Emmons stated his opposition to this project. Planning Commission will be hearing from the DNR in future meetings and public is invited to be present to voice their objection.

Allegan County Legal Assistance Center presented request for funding. Approval as noted under guest speakers occurred.
