<p><b>EMD Director Report</b> Mitigation Plan</p> <p>Spills</p>	<p>Everyone was asked to review their portion of the plan as they are still in the process of completing the survey.</p> <p>Received a NRC report regarding a sheen on the river in Otsego that was reported anonymously. It was checked out by Otsego Fire in the 2900 block of 106<sup>th</sup> Avenue, but was UTL the cause or spill. Ryan Cronk reported that EGLE reported to the incident and indicated that the sheen incident may be coming from the dam project near Morrow Lake that has affected the river and is an ongoing concern.</p> <p>There was a spill on I-196 of 100 gals of diesel. Fire was notified and MDOT and hauler contacted regarding clean up responsibility. Youngs stabilized the diesel spill and will be back out to follow up to remove some soil.</p> <p>Scott asked about receiving cleanup reports from EGLE and Ryan indicated that they don't always get the reports from the contractors, but will send over any available reports and will share Scott's concerns over not receiving reports from the cleanup contractors.</p>		
COVID-19	Emergency Mgt. continues to update the IAP and SitRep and is supporting public health efforts and identifying sites for testing through October as of now. Discussing transitioning to a testing/vaccination clinic setup and have been purchasing tents, tables/chairs and AM radio transmitters for use in this and for EM support in general.
