

Statement of Votes

MARTIN TOWNSHIP ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Martin Township of 4 mills (\$4.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), as reduced to 3.9960 mills by required rollbacks, be renewed and increased by 0.0040 mill up to the original voted 4 mills (\$4.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for ten (10) years, 2016 through 2025, inclusive, for township road improvements; and shall the Township annually levy such 4 mills (\$4.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) on all taxable real and personal property for said purpose?

If approved, this millage will raise an estimated \$373,000 in the first year of the levy. All or a portion of the revenues from this millage will be disbursed to the Allegan County Road Commission for the improvement of public roads within Martin Township.
