

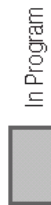
Who Can Use This Service?

Communities in Resource Recovery Program



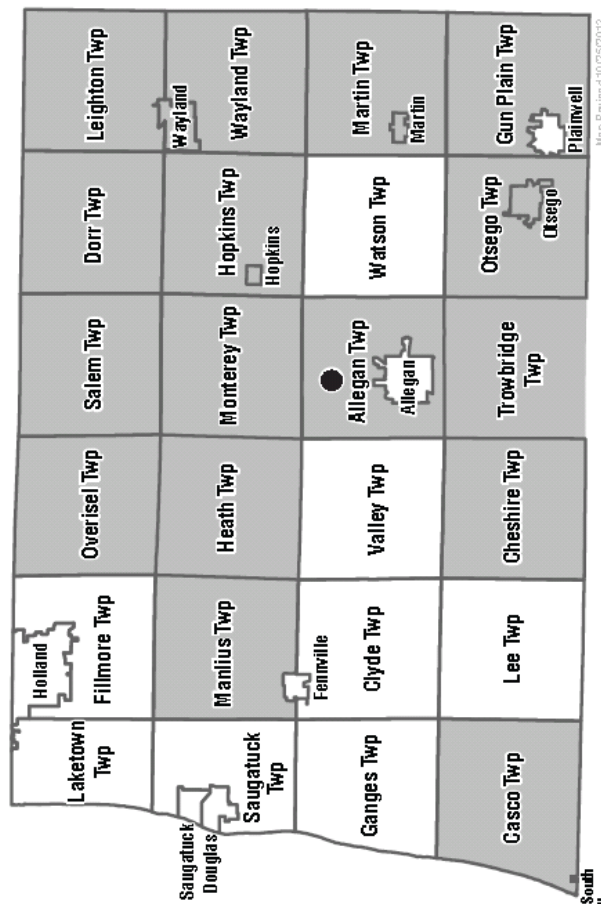

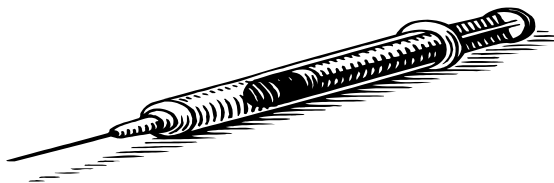

Allegan County Residential Sharps Collection Program

Through the Allegan County Resource Recovery Program, residents are able to drop off used sharps at the Allegan County Health Department by appointment.

Please follow the guidelines below:

1. Contact the Allegan County Health Department, Environmental Health Office at 269-673-5415 to pick up an approved sharps container.
2. Take container home and fill with used sharps. Do not fill over the "Fill-line." **Sharps accepted are: Needles, Syringes, Lancets, etc.**
3. Contact the Allegan County Health Department to schedule an appointment to drop-off your full container.
4. Take a replacement sharps container home.
5. See map on reverse side of brochure. If you live in a Township or City that is **not** in the Resource Recovery Program, read the next section of the brochure to learn how to participate.



For Those Residing in a Non-Participating City or Township

If you reside in a city or township which does **NOT** participate in the Allegan County Resource Recovery Program, the following must be met:

1. Visit the Allegan County Health Department, Environmental Health Office in the Human Services Building at the Allegan County Services Complex, 3255 122nd Avenue, Ste. 200, Allegan.
2. Request a Resource Recovery Card. This annual card will cost \$30⁰⁰ and will provide sharps containers and disposal of sharps for one year.



The Allegan County Resource Recovery Sharps Program is the safest way for residents to protect the environment, waste handlers and others from hazardous sharps!
