### COVID-19 Positive Individual at Marlena's Bistro and Pizzeria

**(Allegan, MI)**— Allegan County Health Department (ACHD) is informing the public that on Saturday, February 27 an individual ate at Marlena's Bistro and Pizzeria located at 909 Lincoln Ave, Holland, MI 49423. Within 48 hours, this individual became symptomatic then tested positive for COVID-19. ACHD was informed on March 3 through case investigation.

Individuals who were at Marlena's Bistro and Pizzeria on Saturday February 27 from 11:00am to 1:00pm are potentially considered exposed to COVID-19 due to the lack of mitigation strategies (mask-use and social distancing) practiced at this restaurant. These individuals should monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19. If individuals develop symptoms, they should [isolate](#) and get tested for COVID-19.

COVID-19 is thought to spread mainly through close contact from person to person, including between people who are physically near each other (within about 6 feet). People who are infected but do not show symptoms can also spread the virus to others. There are three important ways to slow the spread of COVID-19 – wearing a face mask, staying at least 6 feet away from others who do not live with you, and avoiding crowds.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include cough, fever, difficulty breathing, loss of smell or taste, and fatigue. If these symptoms are new or worsening, individuals should speak with their healthcare provider and seek a test for COVID-19. Tests for COVID-19 can be located using the Michigan Department of Health and Human Service's (MDHHS) test site locator at [www.michigan.gov/coronavirustest](http://www.michigan.gov/coronavirustest). There is a free testing event at the Allegan County Transportation Building, located at 750 Airway Dr, Allegan this Saturday from 10:00am to 2:00pm.
