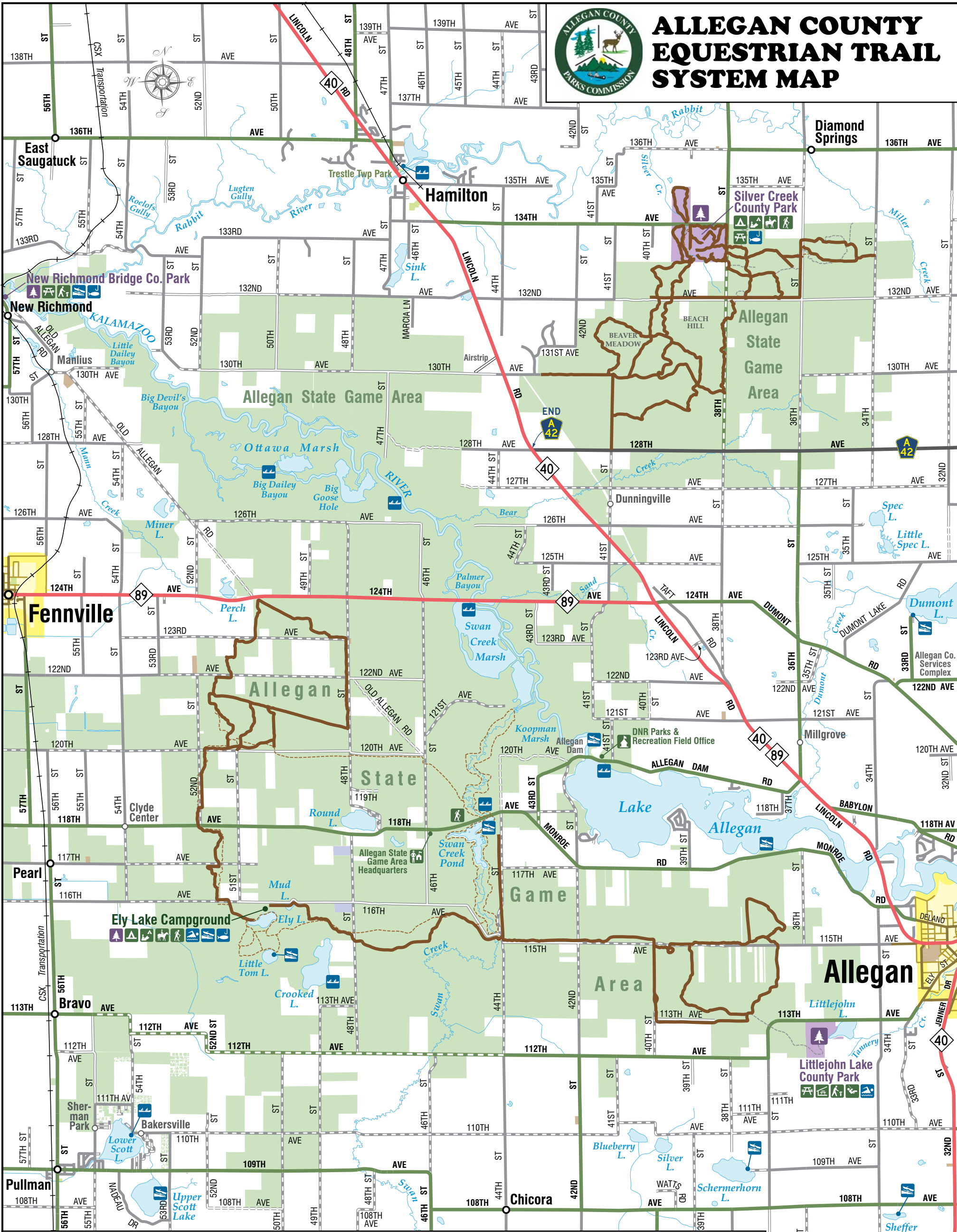




ALLEGAN COUNTY EQUESTRIAN TRAIL SYSTEM MAP



Trail Rules



Typical Allegan County Equestrian Trail Marker. You will find these markers along the trails and at trail junctions.

- Respect all private property!
- Ride on marked trails only!
- Do not move or damage trail markers. (Image of trail marker at left.)
- Practice "Leave No Trace" ethics.
- No loose dogs allowed. All dogs must be on a six-foot (6') leash in the parks and on the trails. (State Law)
- Trails are closed November 15–30 annually for firearm deer season.
- Bright colored clothing always recommended when riding in the fall.

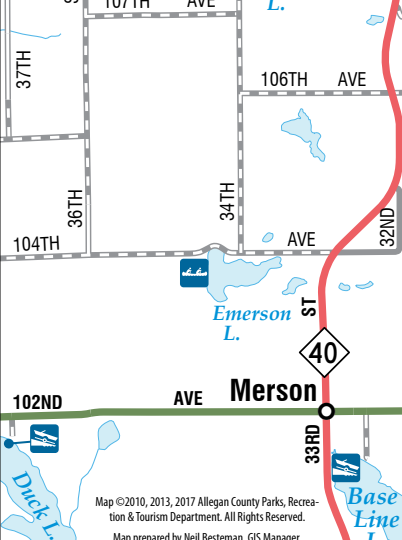
